

## Potato Stockfeed

Potato Stockfeed is a co-product of potato\* processing at the Lamb Weston Meijer plant at Wisbech, Cambs. It includes peeled whole potatoes, steam-peel and uncooked potato chips and is delivered fresh from the factory in a bulk tipping vehicle. This feed stores well in a clean silo with a drainage collection point, and is best used within two weeks. For longer storage periods, the feed should be ensiled and sheeted effectively to restrict the ingress of air.

Potato Stockfeed is a palatable energy-rich feedstuff capable of supporting high levels of animal production. It is suitable for beef and dairy cattle at 15-20 kg per head per day, and is commonly added to other feeds in a mixer wagon. N.B. Potato Stockfeed should always be fed in a daily ration that includes an adequate amount of fibrous feed such as silage or hay.

\*The feed may contain a small proportion of peel and slivers from other root vegetables such as parsnips.
